Classes/Materials Available for Sponsorship

Private Lessons: (Ages 4-18)

Students attend 30 minute private lessons once a week on an instrument of their choice. These lessons are taught by degreed and experienced instructors who focus on musicality, technique, music theory, and music history. Monthly tuition: \$100

Summer Camp: (Ages 5-15)

Students will take classes in rhythm, music theory, music history, and art. Students will also take classes in an instrument of their choice: violin, viola, cello, or keyboard. Each camp is 5 days from 8:00am-12:00pm. There is a small performance on the last day to showcase the students' work. Camp Tuition: \$175

Musikgarten Lessons: (Ages 15 months-3 years)

The Musikgarten curriculum is designed for toddlers and their grown-ups to experience the joy of making music together. These 30 minute weekly classes help to develop the child's language, singing, coordination, and listening skills. These classes are currently offered in 6 week sessions. Musikgarten Tuition: \$65

Instruments: (Ages 4-18)

Instruments for at-home practice are necessary for consistent improvement. Your sponsorship may purchase a new instrument, repair an existing instrument, or purchase a replacement for a student who has outgrown their current instrument. Cost: \$100 - \$1,000

Educational Materials: (Ages 15 months-18 years)

Student materials include books, sheet music, music stands, instrument necessities (strings/shoulder rests/rock stops/rosin/drum sticks etc.), binders, and pencils. Cost: \$10 - \$1,000
